

Rules for Participation and Operation

Drawing with a fixed prize

Eligibility

- Participation is restricted to individuals aged 18 and over who are physically located in the province of Québec at the time of ticket purchase.
- The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the draw: People in charge of the draw; Anthony Haddad (GM Baseball Team) and Frederic Majeur (Head Coach Baseball Team)

Draw

- This is a raffle draw in which the winners will receive the prize associated to the order in which their ticket was pulled. First pull for the 1st prize, second pull for the 2nd prize and so on. The 10th and last ticket pulled will be awarded the 10th prize. The money raised with the raffle will entirely go to John Abbott College for the Baseball Team. Winning tickets will be removed from subsequent drawing lots.
- The sale of tickets will run from February 2nd, 2026, to March 23th, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.
- Tickets will be sold exclusively in person by the members of the baseball team from February 2nd, 2026, to March 23th, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.
- When purchasing in person, participants will receive a ticket stub indicating the numbers associated with the tickets purchased.
- The number of tickets for sale is maxed out at 150 tickets.
- The draw date is March 26th, 2026 (12h00) at John Abbott College, Sports and Recreation department (C-128), 21275 Lakeshore Road, Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue, QC H9X 3L9, where all the tickets will be mixed in a hat and draw will be done by the people in charge.
- Ticket package prices: 1 ticket for \$20.

Draw and Communication with the Winner

- The winner will have fourteen (14) business days from the date of the draw to claim their prize by contacting the organizer by email (fredmajeur@hotmail.com). In order to facilitate the awarding of the prize to the winner, the organizers will also use the contact information provided by the person who purchased the winning ticket to contact them during the claim period.
- The winner must submit a physical copy of their ticket stub and provide two pieces of identification with their name, address, and date of birth, one of which must be a photo ID.

Only the holder of the winning ticket may claim the prize.

- In the event that the holder of the winning ticket has not claimed their prize within fourteen (14) business days, the prize will be given back to the donors.
- The prize awarded to the winner is non-transferable and must be accepted as is, with no substitutions.
- The organizing committee assumes no responsibility for any other person who claims a right to receive all or part of the prize associated with the winning ticket.
- The odds of winning depend on the total number of tickets sold, but are maxed out at 10/150, so 6.67%.

Other terms and conditions

- No official receipt for tax purposes will be issued for the purchase of raffle tickets, as stipulated by the Canada Revenue Agency.
- All ticket sales are final. No refunds will be issued to anyone for any reason. All tickets purchased, including the draw numbers on those respective tickets that are part of the draw, cannot be refunded, even if a ticket purchaser made a mistake in selecting the number of tickets they wished to purchase.
- If the integrity of the draw is compromised in any way, the organization will notify the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec (RACJ) and consult with the RACJ on the best course of action. The organization must receive approval from the RACJ before canceling the draw and/or changing the rules of the draw.
- This draw program is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and municipal laws and regulations. All decisions made by the organizers are final and cannot be appealed.

Public release statement

By participating in the draw, the winner authorizes the organizers and their representatives to disclose their first and last name for all purposes related to the raffle for the organization and its activities, including, but not limited to, advertising and promotional purposes, without any financial compensation.

In the interest of transparency towards other participants and following the draw, the winner's first and last name will be published on various communication tools, including but not limited to, John Abbott College websites, brochures, leaflets, advertisements, and other promotional materials. . This is to prove that the draw did indeed take place and that the prize has been claimed.
